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SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY: Must be a graduating high school student with a permanent residence in Bonner County and have volunteered at least 4 hours of service at the Memorial Community Center.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: The scholarship must be used for the following school year at any accredited college, university, or technical school. Awarded funds, to be used for tuition, fees, and/or books only, will be sent to the school's Financial Aid Office upon the student's proof of matriculation.

Should the recipient of this award drop out during the academic year, the unused portion of the funds will revert to the Memorial Community Center Scholarship Fund. If there is a misuse of funds the scholarship will be terminated and a refund required.

SELECTION POLICY: Scholarships are awarded on the basis of information submitted without regard to sex, race, color, ethnic origin, or creed. Factors used for selection are based on financial need, academic achievement, activities and community involvement including involvement at the Memorial Community Center. Applicants may be asked to appear before the Selection Committee for an interview.

NOTE: The amount of each year's scholarship awards may vary due to the income of the Scholarship Fund.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. **DEADLINE** for application is **April 15th** of each year, with notification each May.
2. The attached application sheets must be submitted in the following order:
 - A. Cover Page
 - B. Data Sheet (page 1)
 - C. Personal History (page 2)
 - D. Student Financial Statement (page 3)
 - E. Extracurricular Activity List (page 4)
 - F. Include a copy of your transcript, GPA, Class Rank, and SAT/ACT scores.
 - G. Provide three letters of recommendation. At least one should be from a teacher who knows you well. The others may be from your employer, minister, or family friend. Do not submit recommendations from relatives.
 - H. Any special requirements for specific scholarships as noted on the front cover.
